

- *Redland Art Awards* is a biennial painting competition open to all Australian artists. Paintings in oil, acrylic, watercolour, pastel and mixed media are acceptable whereas photographs and drawings do not qualify for entry.
 - The competition is open. There are no sections and no specific theme.
 - The maximum size for entries is 2.25 square metres in area.
 - For *Redland Art Awards 2010* the primary award will be a non-acquisitive prize of \$10,000. There will also be two runner up awards of \$4,000 and \$2,500 as well as the Meredith Foxtan People's Choice Award of \$500.
 - Artists may enter up to three paintings for consideration. Of these three, however, **only one painting per artist can be selected for final judging**, if selected at all.
 - Initial entries, CV and artist statement/s must be submitted on CD or DVD accompanied by digital images of less than 3 megabytes that are saved as jpeg files. Jpeg files should be saved as CMYK, 300dpi with the following details as the file name: Artist's surname_artist's first initial_title of painting.jpeg
 - CD/DVDs will be returned after the exhibition only if accompanied by a stamped self-addressed envelope.
 - Entries must be received by close of business Monday 16 August 2010.
 - For entries to be considered they must be accompanied by the entry fee, a CV of not more than one page plus a brief statement about the painting submitted (approximately 100 words). Files should be saved to CD or DVD as word files.
 - **The entry fee is \$25 per entry** and is non-refundable. Payment can be made by cheque or by money order made payable to Redland Yurara Art Society Inc. Please note cash payment cannot be accepted. Receipts will be emailed on receipt of your entry.
 - Redland Yurara Art Society Inc reserves the right not to accept any entry.
 - The selection panel for *Redland Art Awards 2010* will consist of three judges:
 - Anne Wallace, Artist;
 - Simon Mee, Associate Lecturer, Collections Curator and Arts Management, University of Southern Queensland;
 - Emma Bain, Director, Redland Art Gallery.
 - Selected artists (finalists) will be invited to submit their works to Redland Art Gallery, Cleveland between 9am and 3pm on Monday 1 November 2010 for exhibition and consideration by the judge.

 - The judge of the finalists' works will nominate an overall winner of *Redland Art Awards 2010* and two runner up awards. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 - The Meredith Foxtan People's Choice Award will be announced on the *Redland Art Awards* website on Thursday 25 November 2010.
 - Finalists' entries must be displayed for the entire duration of the exhibition.
 - All work submitted for consideration must have a completion date no earlier than 1 January 2009.
 - The submitted work must not be the winner of any other competition.
 - All paintings submitted by finalists must be ready for hanging with d-rings attached. (Distance between top of ring to top of frame = 7.5cm)
 - All paintings must be labelled clearly on the back with artist's name, address and title of work.
 - If works submitted are for sale the price given on the entry form must include GST, if applicable.
 - A commission of 25% will apply to any work sold.
 - Artists of paintings selected for exhibition consent for their works to be reproduced by print and electronic media in the advertising and promotion for current and future *Redland Art Awards*.
 - Artists of paintings selected for the exhibition give consent for their name, state and entry number to be listed on the *Redland Art Awards* website, artwork labels and other print and electronic media.
 - On Tuesday 28 September 2010 artists will be notified of the results of the first stage of judging on the website: www.redlandartawards.org.au. Details will include the names of the successful artists, the states in which they live, and the numbers of the entry (ie. 1, 2 or 3) selected for exhibition as recorded on their entry form. Please note, the title of painting selected for exhibition will not be posted on the website. Therefore, it is important for artists to keep an exact record of their entry details including the number allocated to each entry.
- ### Freight
- Paintings submitted will not be accepted unless delivered and collected free of all freight and transport expenses to and from the exhibition.
 - Paintings are required to be collected at the completion of the exhibition as per the schedule set out below.
 - Should an artist fail to collect a work, after sending notice of intention to dispose of the work, Redland Yurara Art Society Inc may sell the work and after deducting the costs of sale from the proceeds, will hold the balance on behalf of the artist. If the work is deemed unsaleable, then Redland Yurara Art Society Inc retains the right to dispose of the work in a manner deemed appropriate by the Executive Committee of the Society.



Insurance

Adequate insurance will be maintained to cover paintings from time of receipt until their collection, however, **artists will be responsible for insurance of the work whilst in transit.**
